Fehrman lives in Bloomington, Indiana, with his wife and children.

Nick Greenberg is a bassist and composer whose work spans classical, jazz, rock, and Broadway music. He has performed at venues including Carnegie Hall and the Kennedy Center, as well as internationally in Taiwan.
